


Regulatory Review Process and Timeline

CP anticipates a multi-year consultation and review process for the proposed CP Logistics Park: Vancouver in Pitt Meadows, B.C. CP will be seeking public input during engagement in 2020 and 2021.


Local residents and stakeholders will have opportunities to provide feedback to CP, including during engagement events and contact through the project website.

Once CP’s application is received by the Canadian Transportation Agency (CTA) an independent federal agency, it will be reviewed in stages. In the first stage, the application will be assessed for completeness. Once the application has been deemed complete, the CTA will then initiate a public comment process. At this stage, the application will be posted to the CTA website and interested parties will be invited to provide comments directly to the agency.

Throughout the process, the CTA will consider the potential impacts of the project on established or asserted Indigenous rights and interests, and ensure that it fulfills any duty the Crown has to consult and accommodate Indigenous peoples.

After the public comment period closes, the CTA will enter the deliberation stage, when all of the information and feedback provided will be carefully considered. The CTA may ask for additional information at this stage.

After deliberation, the CTA enters the determination stage, at which point a decision will be made on the project and posted on the CTA website. Approval, if granted, may be subject to several conditions that CP would be responsible for satisfying, subject to ongoing monitoring and compliance activities.
